Also, there is still time to register for the Pro-Am Tournament -- a great opportunity to meet and match skills with professional golfers!! More information is available on the LPGA website (see above).

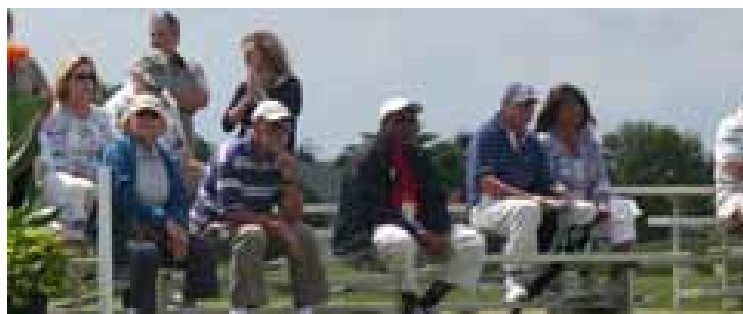
