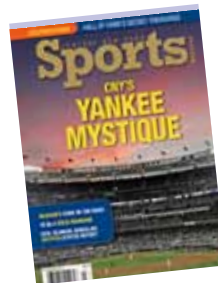

Join the excitement of the LPGA Futures Tour 2011



SYRACUSE, N.Y. – By winning the Section III individual women’s golf title, Lauren Petty, a senior at Charles W. Baker High School in Baldwinsville, qualified for the local amateur exemption from the LPGA Futures Tour and has been invited to play in the 2011 Alliance Bank Golf Classic, presented by Wegmans, this summer. LPGA Futures Tour professional Amelia Lewis, of Jacksonville, Fla., presented the Section III trophy at the conclusion of the tournament at Foxfire at Village Green in Baldwinsville, N.Y. Petty won with a score of 76.

The Alliance Bank Golf Classic is the 11th stop on the 2011 LPGA Futures Tour, known as the “Road to the LPGA.” A field of 144 professional women golfers, representing 30 different countries, will play on the East Course at Drumlins Country Club on Nottingham Road in Syracuse from July 29 to 31. Alliance Bank, N.A. is the title sponsor of the tournament for the sixth consecutive year. This is the 16th consecutive year Syracuse has hosted a Futures Tour tournament and this year’s tournament will again feature a \$100,000 purse.

Advance sale tickets will be available at the customer service desk of all nine Syracuse-area Wegmans locations starting June 27.

Proceeds from the Alliance Bank Golf Classic will benefit The First Tee of Syracuse, an organization dedicated to providing young people an opportunity to develop, through golf and character education, values of honesty, integrity, sportsmanship, respect, confidence and judgment.

Tournament week will also feature Pro-Ams on Wednesday, July 27 and Thursday, July 28 and a Pro-Junior Challenge on Tuesday, July 26. The two Pro-Ams will pair area golfers with LPGA Futures Tour players during a scramble tournament. The Pro-Junior Challenge is a nine-hole high school pro-am, which matches competing foursomes representing women’s golf teams from area high schools with professional golfers from the LPGA Futures Tour.

In previous years, the Alliance Bank Golf Classic has had tremendous success because of the commitment of the volunteers who support the event. As a member of the Drumlins Country Club, you can play an important role because of your experience with the course and facilities.

You may register as a tournament volunteer through the Online Volunteer Registration system.

- All volunteers from last year have a basic account in the system. You may login using the first initial of your first name plus your last name as BOTH your username and password. Example: jdoe or jsmith. Once you have accessed your account, please change your username and password.



- If you have already submitted your registration this year in paper form, we have entered you in the database. Please login using the instructions above to complete your registration.

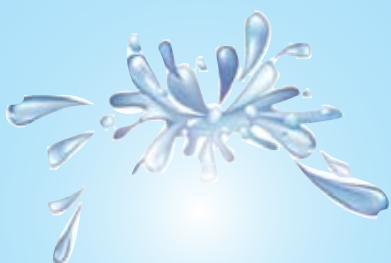
