## THE GOLF SEASON

- The East Course opens on Members' Cleanup Day, Saturday, April 2
- The Management Office is open year round.
- Locker rooms open April 2, and remain open until October 30
- The East Course closes on or about November 20 to allow for winterization of the course in preparation for the coming spring season
- The West Course remains open until weather forces closure

## SIGN-IN

All members and guests are required to sign in at the Golf Shop prior to beginning play.

## BAG TAGS

Drumlins requires that all members have a current East Course bag tag on their golf bag. Tags will be provided to each paid-in-full member by the Management Office prior to the course opening in the spring. Only one tag will be issued to each member. You may find our staff members checking for your tag while you are on the course. Please remember that this is to protect your course from non-member play.

## DRESS CODE

We continue to pursue keeping our private club "professional" in its decorum. Proper attire for men and women is required. A collared or turtle/mock-turtleneck shirt is preferred. The following clothing items are not acceptable: shorts of "gym" style or length, tee shirts, tank tops, jeans, sweat-pants, or tie-dyed shirts. Clothing considered to be too revealing is not allowed.

## CLUB ETIQUETTE

Proper golf etiquette is the hallmark by which each member's conduct is measured. If you feel that rules, regulations, or proper etiquette standards are not being followed, please refrain from attempting to enforce the rules yourself. Please report any incidents to the Golf Shop, and club management will take corrective action.

## MEMBERS MAKE A DIFFERENCE

- You can play a significant role in improving course conditions. Playing conditions for everyone will improve when you take the time to rake traps, place rakes in the bunker once you're finished with them, replace your divots, fix your ball marks, and place trash in receptacles. We also suggest soft spike shoes.
- For safety purposes, we would like to remind all members not to hit into the vicinity of course maintenance workers unless they wave you on. (Since the equipment they use is loud, they are most likely wearing ear protection, and cannot hear you if you yell at them.)
- Before 8 a.m., please yield to the maintenance staff when you meet them on a hole on the course.

## CLUB STORAGE AREA

Club storage is located next to the golf shop. This club storage will be operated by Drumlins personnel. Clubs will be brought out, placed on carts, taken off carts, and cleaned after each use. The cost for the season will be \$75 per bag or \$100 for a family. Stop by the golf shop to reserve your spot.

## WEATHER DELAYS

When it is determined that a weather delay (most often a frost delay) is necessary, members are asked to completely refrain from beginning their round or practicing on the putting green(s) until a Drumlins Golf Shop representative approves play to begin. The approval for play is made by Drumlins management or professional staff.

If a weather delay occurs during starting time days, members with a starting time will be given preference over those without. If, for instance, there is a two-hour delay due to a moderate frost, then the member with a 7:00 AM starting time would tee off at 9:00 AM and the member with a 10:00 AM starting time would tee off at 12:00 Noon. Members who arrived before starting times have no status.

In the case of all weather delays, every effort is made to get all people off the course as quickly as possible.

## LOCKER ROOMS

- In the men's locker room there is no attendant on duty. You should contact the Management Office at the start of the season, and we will help you to select a locker, if you wish. Drumlins provides locker room amenities such as towels, soap and shampoo.
- In the ladies' locker room there is no attendant on duty. Towels, as well as other amenities, are always available in the shower area.
- For both locker rooms, please provide your own lock.

## STARTING TIMES

You may call or come into the Golf Shop beginning at 7:00 AM one week before your desired starting time.

You must register the names of everyone in your foursome, and are limited to signing-up one group. Hence, you may sign up on Saturday for the following Saturday, and Sunday for the following Sunday, etc. Starting times run from 7:00 AM until 12:45 PM on weekends and holidays. Additional conditions are:

### **TEE TIMES ON SATURDAY & SUNDAY MORNING - YOU MAY BRING ONLY ONE GUEST PER MEMBER**

Starting times are in effect from Friday, April 29 through Sunday, October 2.

## CLUB CARD

Drumlins has a renewable, declining balance Club Card available for you in any denomination. Please purchase your card in the Business Office. The card can be used for all purchases except lessons and merchandise.



## GOLF CART POLICY

Golf carts are rented and assigned in the golf shop.

All persons using golf carts are responsible for proper payment, signing the contract, and for adhering to Drumlins’ policies for the use of golf carts.

These policies include:

- Operation of a golf cart is restricted to those 18 years and older in possession of a valid driver’s license.
- Two is the maximum number of riders on a golf cart, and all riders must be seated.
- Carts are rented on a 9-hole or 18-hole basis.
- Golf carts may be driven no closer than thirty feet from any tee or green
- Operators must abide by all directional signs, access barriers, and any directives issued in response to special circumstance.
- Operators must stay on cart paths where directed to do so.
- Use of golf carts in Drumlins parking lot is prohibited.
- Operators are prohibited from tampering with the speed governor or other safety devices.

A members’ cart rental privileges may be suspended or revoked for failing to abide by Drumlins’ golf cart use policy.

## THE MEN'S ASSOCIATION (DEGA)

The Drumlins East Golf Association (DEGA) is the men's association of the East Course. DEGA organizes the men's tournaments and social functions.

A calendar of events is included in this handbook. The monthly calendar and Scorecard newsletter are emailed to all members and are posted online at [www.drumlins.com](http://www.drumlins.com)

**DEGA stipulates that Longshadows League, the ABC Championship, Burlingame Member-Member events, the Club Championship and the President's Cup tournaments are open to all male members 18 years of age or older.**

**Longshadows** - This is the 9-hole Thursday evening men's league. The format of this league is "four-ball" between two 2-man teams competing in match play each week. Please contact Jim Cody at 449-2122 with any questions. The first and tenth tees are reserved between 4:30 and 5:30 p.m. for the league. The opening matches will begin at **4:30 PM on Thursday, April 21**, weather permitting.

**Tuesday Morning Men's Senior League** - Each week there is an event scheduled for 18 holes. Teams are selected by drawing cards. Scoring utilizes a modified Stapleford system. Friendly competition makes this a fun day on the golf course. Please note **Tuesday, April 19** as the starting date.

## DEGA-SPONSORED EVENTS

**Men's ABC Championship** - This is our individual match play championship conducted in handicap divisions. "A" 0-9; "B" 10-15; "C" 16 and over. Players will play at 80% of their handicap at the time of the match. "A" Players contact Mark Regin; "B" Players Jim Cody, "C" Players Dave Kirby

**There is a separate entry fee. The first round will be played Saturday, May 14, or Sunday, May 15. Subsequent rounds must be completed by Sunday, June 12; Sunday, July 10; Sunday, August 7; and Sunday, September 4.**

Future matches can be scheduled at the participants leisure before the round deadline. However, all participants must notify Sean Dadey of date and time for all subsequent matches. If a match is not played by the required date, both teams will be disqualified. The number of entries will determine the number of rounds played. Rounds will be completed until there is a tournament champion. All rulings will be determined by the Golf Shop.

## MEN'S EVENTS

**Burlingame Member-Member** - A permanent cup has been established for this prestigious event in honor of the son of Drumlins' founder, Rod Burlingame, Sr. The Rod Burlingame Junior Cup will be presented each year and is donated by his widow, Edna Burlingame Burns.

The format for this popular event will be two-man stroke play, to be played over the course of the summer with predetermined dates for completion. It is a handicap event with the low-handicap player playing at "0" handicap. Other players play at 80% of the difference.

Example:

Player A	10 handicap .....	plays at 0
Player B	12 handicap .....	plays @ $2 \times .80 = 2$
Player C	14 handicap .....	plays @ $4 \times .80 = 3$
Player D	16 handicap .....	plays @ $6 \times .80 = 4$

The first round is scheduled for **Saturday, June 4 or Sunday, June 5. Subsequent rounds MUST be completed by Sunday, June 27; Sunday, July 25; Sunday, August 22; and Sunday, September 19.** Future matches can be scheduled at the participant's leisure before the round deadline. However, all participants must notify Sean Dadey of date and time for all subsequent matches. If a match is not played by the required date, both teams will be disqualified. The number of entries will determine the number of rounds played. Rounds will be completed by the above dates until there is a tournament champion. All rulings will be determined by the Golf Shop.

**Men's Ryder Cup** - Drumlins third annual DEGA Ryder Cup tournament will take place on **Saturday, June 11** (tee times).

Two team captains will be selected who will draft each team. The event will consist of three 9-hole matches: 1) alternate shot; 2) singles; and 3) four-ball (best ball). Each match is worth one team point.

Participants must have an established GHIN handicap at the time of the event (or will play at scratch) and will play at 80% of their handicap. The Ryder Cup will include a buffet lunch and prizes immediately following (approximately 2:00 p.m.). Please contact **Joe Lore** for more information.

## MEN'S EVENTS

**Father/Son/Brother/Brother** - This popular event will return for the 2011 season on **Saturday, June 18**. The event is open to all fathers, sons and brothers of Drumlins. The format will consist of 9 holes of best-ball and 9 holes of Captain/Mate. Tee times for this event will begin at 9:00 a.m. There is a separate entry fee. Mark Regin is the coordinator for this event.

**Drumlins East Course 3-Day Member-Guest** - This event is open to all male members and has become the most popular competitive and social event of the season. This year a Women's Flight will be included (minimum of 4 teams). The event is scheduled for **Thursday, Friday & Saturday, July 14, 15 & 16**. As the event nears, all East Course members will receive an invitation and schedule of events. For more information, please contact Mark Regin at 391-3823.

**President's Cup** - The President's Cup is a two-day competition using the Ryder Cup-type format, which uses best ball, Captain/Mate scramble, and alternate shot formats. This event will be held on **September 10 & 11**. Contact the Golf Shop for any additional details. The event has been streamlined to ensure great competition and greater participation.

**Men's Club Championship** - The Drumlins East Club Championship is rich in history. Past winners include some of Central New York's finest amateur players. All men age 18 or older are eligible to participate in this championship. Participants will be flighted after the first 18 holes on **Saturday, August 13**. The Golf Shop and tournament committee will do the pairings on the first day. Pairings will be determined by score for the second day, which is **Sunday, August 14**. The leaders tee off last. The top five finishers will be recognized by earning the privilege to represent Drumlins East in the SDGA Interclub Tournament.

**One-Day Member-Guest** - These events are open to both male and female members. Events are planned for May 20 (Bare Bones format, Chair Craig Mead); June 22 (Chair Larry Lewandowski, August 17 Chair Mark Regin). Each event is different, but all are 18-hole events and include lunch, greens fees for guest, cart, dinner and prizes. Watch for information as these events near.

**Men's Senior/Super Senior Club Championship** - This is a "White Tee" event with both a scratch and handicap division. "Supers" will have one winner in each division. Players must declare which division they are playing in before teeing off. If the player does not declare it is assumed that he is playing in the scratch division. The "Super Senior" division is open to all male members who have reached their 65th birthday on or before Aug. 6, 2011.

## WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

The Drumlins East Women's Golf Association (DEWGA) is the East Course women's association. DEWGA includes all women who have playing privileges on the East Course and operates under approved by-laws.

The leagues available for women are an 18-hole Thursday morning league, a Tuesday evening 9-hole league. You may play in one or both league(s). Each league has a league coordinator and its own treasury. Each league's treasury is supplemented by a small amount from DEWGA. In addition to paying dues, you must also have an official handicap. With five scores, you may be given a temporary handicap. You must have ten scores posted in order to play in tournaments, guest days, and other club-wide events.

The calendar of events and other information are posted on the bulletin board located in the Members' Lounge next to the handicap computer. A DEWGA calendar is also prepared and included in this handbook. League calendars will be available at the opening breakfast or from league representatives. ## WOMEN'S EVENTS

**Members' Opening Event** - This event will be held Saturday, April 30. There will be breakfast and a shotgun start. Anyone planning to play golf must sign up at the Golf Shop. More information will be available by email and at the Golf Shop. Registration for leagues will take place ahead of the Opening Event, either by mail or by email.

**Member-Member Tournament** - This tournament is a season-long event and is open to all women members who have an established handicap. A handicap is established by a minimum of ten posted scores (remember that you must post all 9- and 18-hole scores). Two-person teams compete in a single elimination format. This tournament is chaired by **Mary Read**.

**Women's Member-Guest** - This tournament is scheduled for Saturday, July 23, with a 9 a.m. shotgun start. This event is open to all women members of Drumlins East and their guests. More details will be announced. This tournament is chaired by **Mary Read and Joanne Cehovin**.

**Eclectic Tournament** - This event will be held on Saturday and Sunday, June 25 & 26. Both gross and net scores are recorded for the first day of play. On the second day, you play to better your score on each hole. Whichever score is better on the first or second day is the final score registered. **Sheila Taughter and Fran Volinsky** chair this event.

**Senior and Super Senior Club Championship:** This is a two-day event being played simultaneously on August 6 & 7. The Senior Club Championship is open to all Drumlins East women golf members 50 years of age or older. The Super Senior Event is open to all Drumlins East women golf members 65 years of age and older. These are non-handicapped events, with the title of Senior Club Champion going to the member having the lowest two-day score without a handicap and the title of Super Senior Club Champion going to the member having the lowest two-day score without a handicap.

**Club Championship and President's Cup** - These are two-day events. They will be played simultaneously on Saturday and Sunday, August 13 and 14. Drumlins East women golf members eighteen and older are eligible to play in this tournament. The title of Club Champion is given to the member having the lowest two-day score total without a handicap. The President's Cup winner is the member having the lowest two-day score total with a handicap. A round of 18 holes will be played each day unless otherwise specified. **Cindy Granger** chairs this event.

## WOMEN'S EVENTS

**Modified Solheim Cup** - This is a two-day tournament consisting of two-person teams competing for the overall low score after two days of competition. Formats include two-person best ball, alternate shots, combined net score and Captain & Mate. Handicaps are used in all segments of the event. This is a fun event open to all ability levels. Plan on playing, grab a partner, sign up, and enjoy this change of pace tournament. The event is scheduled for Saturday & Sunday, August 27 & 28, and is chaired by **Rita Bratek**.

**Chilly Challenge** - This 9-hole, two-person, best-ball event is scheduled for Sunday, October 16 at noon. This event is chaired by **Barb Moon**.
