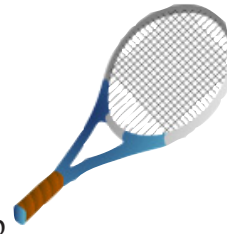

Tip from the Pro –

Hitting the Ball on the Rise

The purpose of hitting the ball on the rise is to be able to take the ball early and take time away from your opponent. This takes timing, balance and being able to hit the ball in your strike zone. Balance is important, as well as an adjustment in the length of your backswing depending on the flight and speed of the ball. Move to the ball and be prepared to take it "early" off the bounce. Play the ball. Don't let the ball play you.
